

Compilation of movies of Outdoor Activities taken by Warren & Audrey (Christenot) Stevens (1952-1971)

PACKTRIPS, FISHING, HUNTING, CATTLE DRIVE, AND GLACIER & YELLOWSTONE PARKS – Many trips were taken for weeks at a time in the wilderness. Appearances by cousins not listed here will be added as identified.

1. Reel 5 Yellowstone Park and hunting movies with Warren Stevens. Myron Stevens, Dean Stevens and Lee LeClair.
2. Reel 6 1953 Glacier Part and Crow Indian celebration at Absarokee. Getting ready and starting pack trip from cabin at West Fork of the Gallatin. Pack horse bucked off the pack and Warren, Audrey, and Wayne Stevens with Ethle and Cecil Siefert picking up afterwards. We continued with the pack trip to Ulrey Lake and fished. Then we camped on the inlet to Yellowstone Lake. Near the end of this reel Warren Stevens hunting movies with Dean Stevens riding an elk carcass down a steep hill.
3. Reel 11 1953 Glacier Nat. Park with **Helen & Harley Christenot family** (Harley was the fourth son of George & Ella Christenot) with Warren, Audrey and Wayne Stevens.
4. Reel 7 1953 Fairy Lake and Warren and Audrey and Wayne pack trip to Ulrey Lake and Spanish Peaks with **Orville, Annette, & Paul Christenot** in 1954 also a pack trip with Cecil and Ethel Siefert into the Blue Danube Lake in the Hilgard area of MT.
5. Reel 12 1953 Fishing trips, pack trips, hunting movies and Yellowstone Park.
6. Reel 13 1953 Cattle drive for Albert Berg, with Don Berg, Byron Berg Warren and Wayne Stevens near Martinsdale, MT.
7. Reel 26 1954 Trip to Mystic Lake on West Rosebud Creek in Bear Tooth Mountains and the Mystic Lake Montana Power Station with the large water pipe providing the hydraulic force for the power turbine. Warren and Audrey Stevens lived at this site when they were first married. **Roy Kyle** worked at the power station for Montana Power and Doris Kyle did housekeeping at the village and Audrey assisted Doris with her duties. Roy Kyle was the sixth child of John & Hattie (Christenot) Kyle.
8. Reel 31 1954 Gallatin County Caterpillar was submerged in the Gallatin River near the Axtel Bridge and a diver was used to connect a chain to the cat to allow it to be pulled from the river.
9. Reel 8 1955 Yellowstone National Park movies.
10. Reel 21 1956 Warren Stevens and wildlife game officials tagging elk in the Gallatin Canyon, MT.
11. Reel 22 1956 Pack trip into the Spanish Peaks to Diamond Lake Warren, Audrey and Wayne Stevens with Cecil, Ethel, and Jack Siefert, also pack trip to Ulreys Lake and to Big Sprints in the West Fork of the Gallatin River in an area now owned by the Yellowstone Millionaires Club.
12. Reel 24 1957 Hunting movies by Warren Stevens.
13. Reel 17 1958 Yellowstone Park movies.
14. Reel 36 1964 Horse jumping competition at Gallatin County Fair Grounds at Bozeman, MT.
